

Multi-Trade Level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship

Duration: 12-24 months (dependent on prior qualifications)

Who is the apprenticeship for?

This programme is for staff who work in a multi-discipline environment undertaking a range of construction trade duties. Employers will need to offer the opportunity for an apprentice to gain work experience in the units listed

Entry requirements

Applicants must be aged 16 and over with preferably GCSEs A-D in Maths and English. GCSE Science is also preferable.

What qualifications are delivered?

- ◆ Diploma in Building Maintenance Multi Trade Repair & Refurbishment Operations (Level 2)
- ◆ NVQ Diploma in Building Maintenance Multi Trade Repair & Refurbishment (Level 2)
- ◆ Employee rights and responsibilities
- ◆ Personal learning and thinking skills

What does the apprenticeship cover?

Apprentices will cover aspects of all construction trades, including but not limited to: plastering, plumbing, carpentry, tiling, painting & decorating and roofing.

NVQ Building Maintenance Multi Trade Repair & Refurbishment (Level 2)

Mandatory Units:

- ◆ Health, safety & welfare in construction and associated industries
- ◆ Erect & dismantle access equipment and working platforms
- ◆ Understanding information, quantities & communication with others
- ◆ Understanding construction technology
- ◆ Carry out masonry trade repairs
- ◆ Carry out painting & decorating trade repairs
- ◆ Carry out plastering trade repairs
- ◆ Carry out wood trade repairs
- ◆ Carry out tiling trade repairs
- ◆ Carry out roofing trade repairs
- ◆ Develop customer relationships

Training Programme

This programme is delivered by attending college 12 hours per week over 1 day and 1 evening. The Assessor visits the apprentice every other month for approximately 2 hours for assessment and training. In addition quarterly review meetings will be scheduled to track progress, involving the line manager, assessor and apprentice.
